dining room. Don't be late.

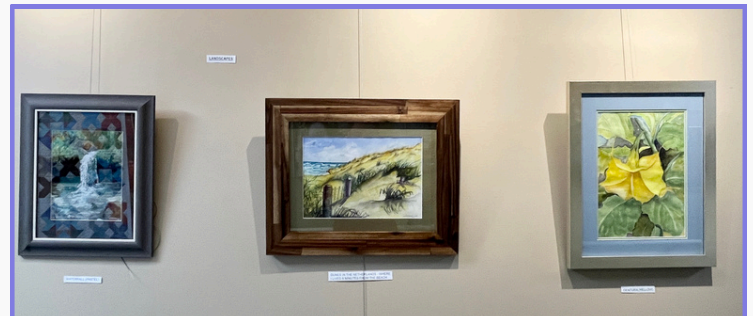
And when a Village resident moves on,

Check your iPad; it will be a big help for you.



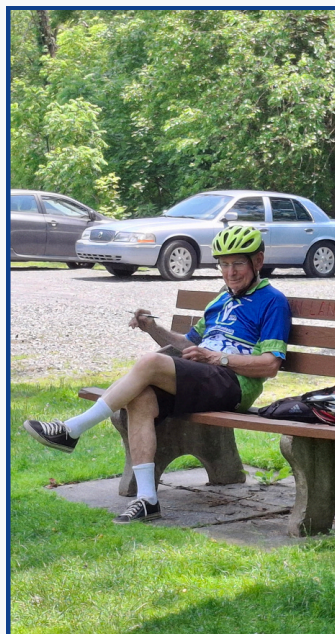
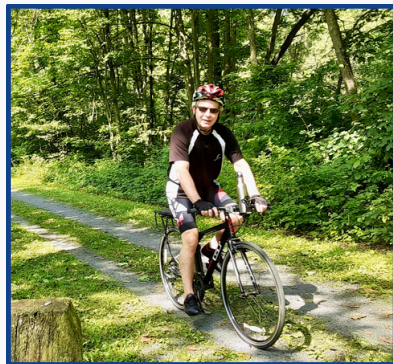
# Resident Art Wall

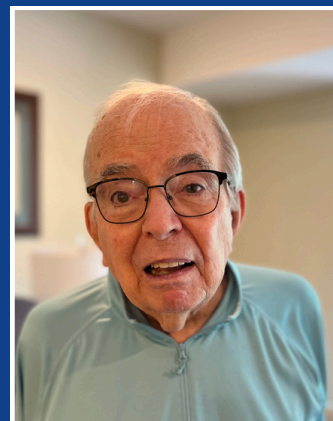

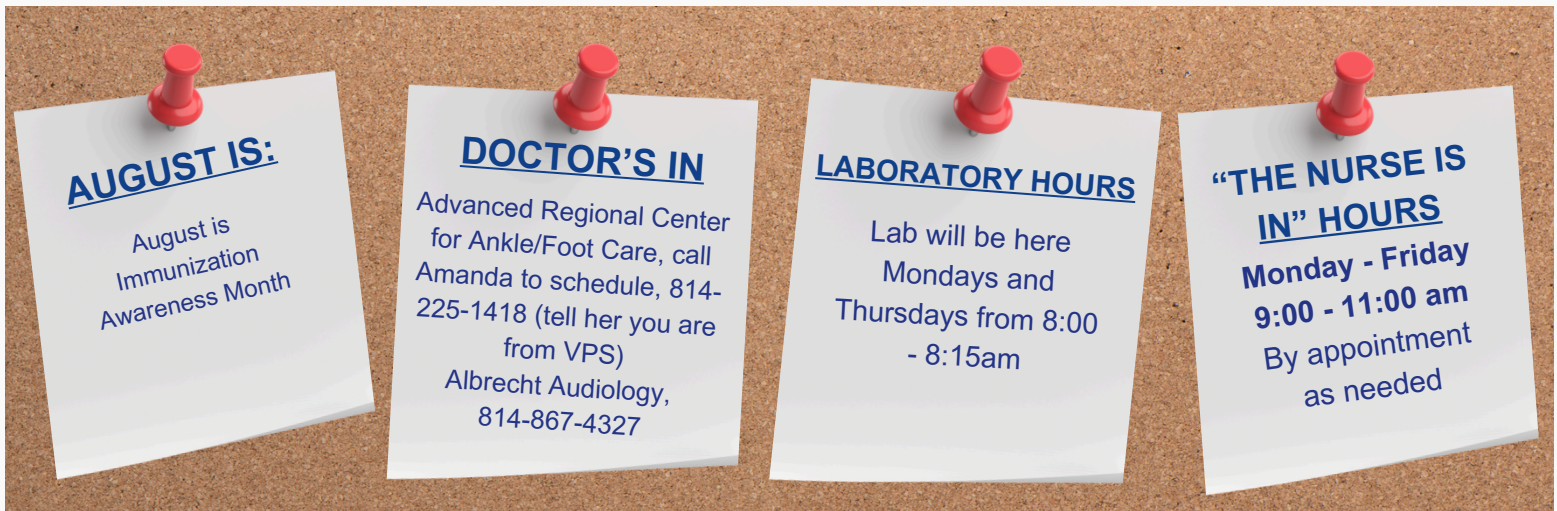
