people

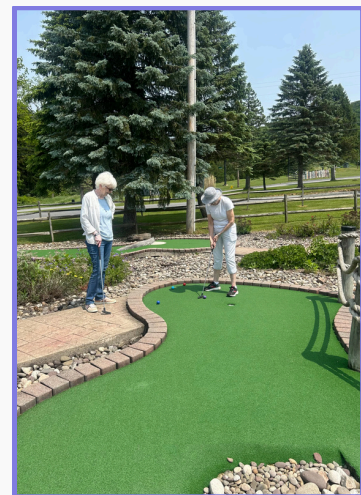
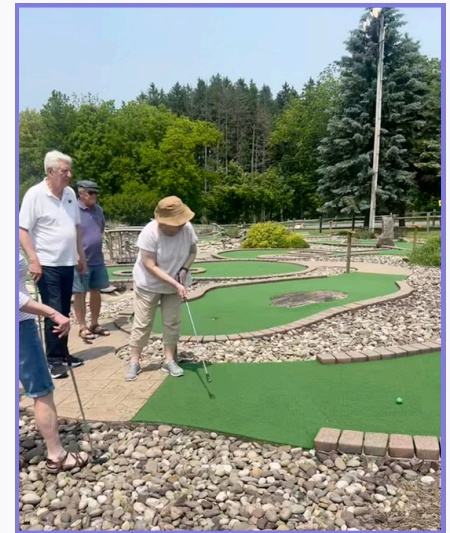

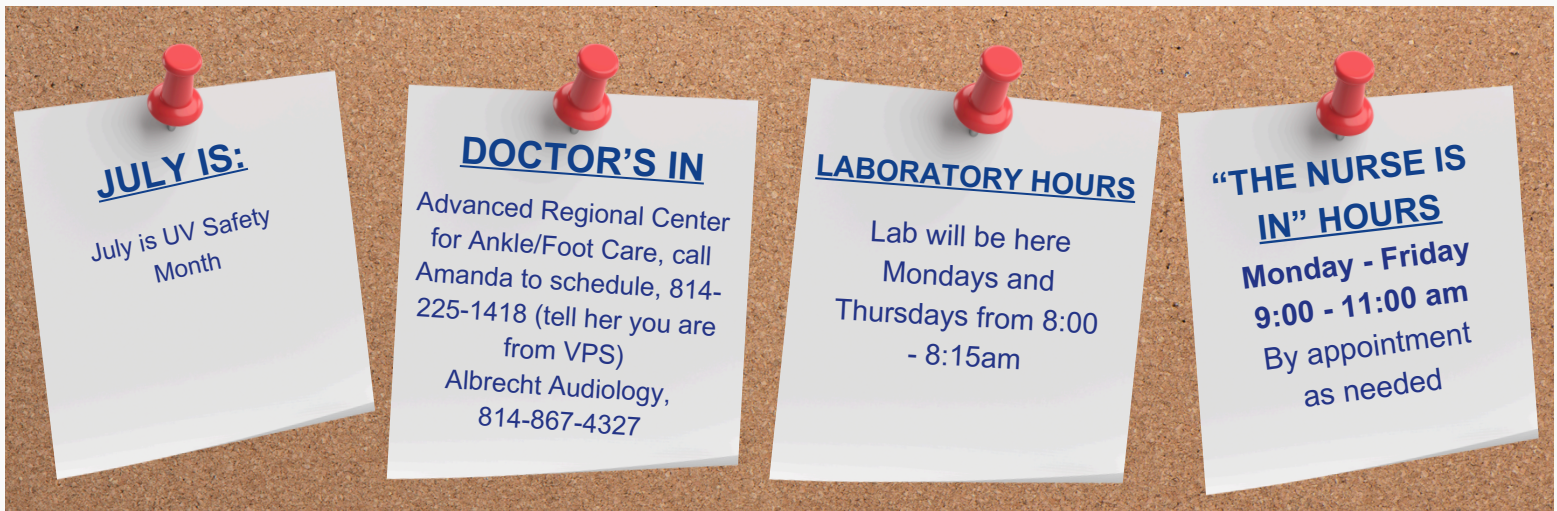


# National Donut Day
