Takeaway Message: Just make it a habit to rinse before you recycle. It’s easy peasy.

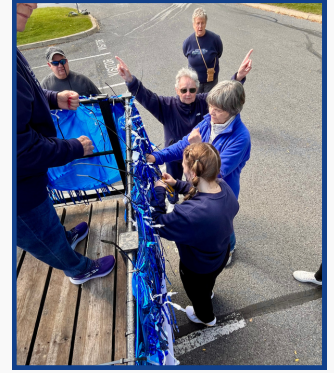
